Excursion of Peterhoff Park & Palace: The spectacular parkland at Peterhof is remarkable for the sheer variety of styles encompassed in its layout and features. Representing nearly two centuries of European aristocratic fashion executed to the highest standards, Peterhof is like an encyclopedia of park design through the age of empire. Visit to Hermitage Museum (a MUST DO): Visit one of the biggest museums in Europe, which is also one of the most unique in terms of the heritage and being a home to Tzars of the past.

Excursion of St. Isaac Cathedral: In 2021, the State Museum-Monument "St. Isaac's Cathedral" celebrated 90 years since its opening. Recognized as a national treasure, St. Isaac's Cathedral was not listed in the lists of church architecture buildings that were subject to demolition. The birthday of the museum is considered to be April 12, 1931. On this day, or rather, on the night of April 11-12, the State Anti-Religious Museum was opened in St. Isaac's Cathedral with a solemn demonstration of Foucault's experience. This date was an important milestone not only in the history of the museum, but also in the history of the cathedral itself as an outstanding architectural monument.

River and Canals boat ride: Enjoy the most memorable sights of palaces and mansions of Saint-Petersburg from the water while having a small cruise along Saint-Peterburg streets)

Day 05: MOSCOW - Vehicle from 1000 to 2100 hrs / Meet Guide & leave for sightseeing

MOSCOW SIGHTSEEING —City Tour, Red Square, GUM Store, Kremlin Entrance: This morning, proceed on a guided panoramic city tour (outside only) of Moscow, which includes the iconic Red Square and the stunning St. Basil's Cathedral with its colorful onion-shaped domes. After observing St. Basil's Cathedral, Lenin Mausoleum, Red Square, sparrow hills, University - Novodevichy Convent. Later Proceed to visit Moscow Kremlin territory with cathedrals - The Kremlin is an ancient fortress which is considered to be the heart of Russia. Nowadays the Kremlin is an official residence of the president of Russian Federation. Kremlin Museums - Armoury Chamber Armory Chamber is a unique treasure-house in the heart of Moscow, The Fund is housed in the Armory Chamber The State Historical Museum and other sights of the area we move along the Moskva River embankment. On the way, we enjoy views of Kremlin, and continue to the Cathedral of the Christ the Savior, New Maidens Convent, Moscow State University. Visit to the Sparrow Hills observation spot opens outstanding view on Moscow. Then we travel to the Memorial Complex at Poklonnaya Hill and Victory Park, Triumphal Arch, Kutuzov Avenue, New Arbat, Boulevard ring, Pushkin square, Tverskaya street.

Visit of the Red Square: Red Square is regarded as one of the most famous squares in Europe and the world. In addition, it has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1990.

Visit of Zaryadye Park with Hanging Bridge Zaryadye Park is a landscape urban park located adjacent to the Red Square. Time Magazine included this in the list of World's greatest places in 2018.

Victory Park & Sparrow Hills with One way Cable Car: Victory Park is a memorial complex dedicated to Russia's victory over Nazi Germany. It is located in the historic area of Moscow known as Poklonnaya Hill, which means "Bow Hill". It's one of the highest spots in Moscow - in old times travellers approaching the capital from the west used to climb onto the hill to get a beautiful panoramic view of the city, and would bow to Moscow Excursion to the highest point in Moscow, Sparrow Hills & enjoy Cable car ride (one way) Enjoy a breathtaking fly over the Moskva River! A new centre of gravity on Vorobyovy Hills, Moscow's first cable car spans the two banks of the Moskva River. It is difficult to imagine another place in Moscow where a cable car would fit in as organically, or be as much in demand as here.

Visit Sergiev Posad & Entry to Sergiev Trinity Metro Tour: Famous for being the most beautiful metro system in the world, each metro station has a story to tell. An entirely different design for each station, the Russian metro is a sight for sore eyes with the statues and chandeliers that line the ceilings! On the way, we will stop at various metro stations to learn about the history of each station and appreciate the marble floors, mosaic, and stain glass work that makes these metro stations so tasteful and elegant. While some stations look like palaces, others look like picture galleries. Later, stroll down Arbat Street, now an extensive and enthralling pedestrian walkway, filled with interesting shops and restaurants.

VDNKH: This magnificent park in the north of Moscow features more than 250 Soviet-era palaces and pavilions, arches and fountains, a Vostok rocket, and Soviet aircraft. The Soviet name VDNKh is an acronym meaning "the Exhibition of the Achievements of the National Economy".
