Five generations now have watched the Temple progress in Barcelona. Today, more than 135 years after the laying of the cornerstone, construction continues on the Basilica. Next we to one of the most popular day trip from Barcelona – Montserrat. It a visit to a unique mountain range offering views over Catalonia. Venture into the Catalan countryside to visit Montserrat on this full-day tour from Barcelona.
