Day 1: Arrival Siem Reap – Angkor Thom

Arrive Siem Reap, Siem Reap. Treasure of the Kingdom of Cambodia, special welcome to everybody, a moment of courtesy. You meet your guide and transfer to hotel for early check in .

Then you will starting tours to visit the West Gate of Angkor Thom – undiscovered by mass of tourists

- The ancient capital of Angkor Thom (12th century),
- See the South Gate, Bayon Temple – unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara,
- Baphuon temple lying just to the north of Bayon a pyramidal representation of mythical Mont Meru,
- We step to see our old palace as Phimeanakas temple in huge complex that was used for our king in the past time,
- Then Elephant terrace platform for king and officers to view shows and people meeting,
- Preah Palilay older than Angkor Thom, deeply in the forest and on path back You see monks sprinkle water to people.
- Ta Prohm, “Tomb Raider” fame. Ta Prohm has been abandoned to the elements, a reminder that while empires rise and fall, the riotous power of nature marches on, oblivious to the dramas of human history. Left as it was ‘discovered’ by French explorer Henri Mouhout in 1860, the tentacle-like tree roots here are slowly strangling the surviving stones, man first conquers nature to create, nature later conquers back to destroy. We visit Ta Prohm early to avoid the masse of crowd and provide a unique visit in this incredible temple.

Day 02: Siem reap – Angkor watt

We continue to the famous temple : Angkor Wat. Angkor Wat is a World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendor. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology.

We journey to the mountain temple of Phnom Bakheng to see the sunset cast its soft light over Angkor Wat. A winding path cuts through the jungle or there is the option of an elephant ride to the summit. This temple is the signature spot for sunset, so it can get very crowded. Please advise the guide if you want to experience sunset at a quieter location.

Cruise along a short tributary, passing fishermen and children playing in the shallow waters before arriving at a typical floating village where you may either disembark or cruise amongst the waterways

08:30 Driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel

11:30-12:00 Upon arrival at Tuan Chau International Cruise Port, you will enjoy a warm welcome by our cruise staff in the waiting lounge and complete check-in procedure.

Along the way, you can enjoy the view of some of the most beautiful spots in Ha Long and admire the grandeur of the Bay with thousands of limestone islands while the vessel heads to Luon Cave & Titop Island.

Enjoy your lunch at our luxurious restaurant on board while the vessel cruises toward Luon Cave.

14.00: You return to your cabin for a short rest and prepare for kayaking activities in Luon Cave.

Arriving at Luon Cave area, you will participate in kayaking or rafting here around the thousand-year-old rock formations.

16.00: You will be transferred to Titop Island by tender .

Visit Titop Island and hike to the top for stunning views of Ha Long Bay, or have a fun swim in the clear blue water.

17.30-18.00 Back on board, you will participate in Sunset party & cooking class while the vessel cruises toward the shore. You can enjoy relaxing moments while sipping a cup of traditional Vietnamese tea or coffee on the sundeck amid wonderful scenery and beautiful sunset. Ha Long Bay is calm during the day, but when the sun goes down, the Bay becomes even more tranquil and peaceful.

You will be instructed to make delicious Fresh Spring rolls by our chef and then enjoy the rolls made on your own.

17.30-18.30 Happy hour – BUY 2 DRINK GET 1 FOR FREE(on your own)

19.30 Gala Dinner. Enjoy your dinner on the Sundeck (if the weather is favourable)

20.30 After dinner, you will enjoy a peaceful view of the Bay at night on the deck. You can also participate in evening activities such as herbal foot bath in your room (free of charge), Bamboo dancing, fashion show traditional customs “Footsteps of Heritage” and some drinks at Sky Bar and massage (subject to additional charge), while admiring breathtaking view of the Bay at night and squid fishing.

Day 05: Ha Long Bay – Hanoi – Hanoi city tour

06.15: Start your day with Tai Chi class on the sundeck.

06.30-07.00 Enjoy a light breakfast with coffee, tea, cake and fruit.

07.30 Exploring Sung Sot cave. This is one of the largest and most beautiful caves in Ha Long Bay. The cave has some unique rock formations which couldn't be found anywhere else. The path to the mouth of Sung Sot Cave is under a canopy of leaves. Walking through steep stone steps, tourists may have the feeling of climbing on mountains and experience the excitement as if they are stepping to the sky.

08.30-09.30 Back on board, you can rest in your room, enjoy the herbal foot bath prepared by our crew, sunbathe on the sundeck, take pictures of Halong Bay or shop for souvenirs on the boat.

09.30 Check-out time.

Please put your luggage outside your cabin and leave the room key at the reception desk. Our staff will transfer your luggage to the waiting area. While waiting, you can shop for some products of Amanda cruise.

10.00 Enjoy an early lunch buffet at the restaurant on the 2nd floor and settle the bills if any.

11.00 Arrival at Tuan Chau Marina. The trip ends.

Hanoi Half day City Tour:

Visiting the Temple of Literature, which is well known as the first university of Vietnam.

Next to Tran Quoc Pagoda - located on an east side isle of the West Lake (Tay Ho district), It is considered as the most ancient pagoda in Thang Long - Ha Noi with its historical progression in 1500 years.

It has a harmonious combination between the majesty, hoariness architecture and peaceful landscape of the West Lake. From the period in the Ly and Tran dynasties, it had become the Buddhist center of Thang Long.

We will continue to visit the peaceful lake of Hoan Kiem. After that, we will visit St. Joseph's Cathedral. It is a late 19th-century Gothic Revival church that serves as the cathedral of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Hanoi to nearly 4 million Catholics in the country.

Day 06: Hanoi – Danang – Coconut Forest – Hoi an with release lantern

Breakfast Check out the hotel and depart to Noi Bai airport for the flight to Danang

Upon arrive in Danang, you will be greeted by our guide and driver.

Have lunch at Indian restaurant in Danang

Proceed to - Visit Bay Mau Coconut Forest on basket boats, a typical vehicle of the fishing village of Van Lang village. You can see the local people casting their nets on the river to catch fish and can experience their own casting skills. Then, watch the unique basket-shaking performance of the basket-shaking artisan of Van Lang village You will discover the city of Hoi An on foot. This historic city, which was a prosperous port city from the 16th to the 18th century, is now a beautiful city not to be missed. We will transfer to go to Hoi An Old Town. You will have an opportunity to visit Hoi An Market, Historical House, Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, Japanese Covered Bridge and Art Craft Manufacturing with artwork galleries in the town.

Admire Hoi An at sunset, this is a very romantic time

Release lanterns in Hoi An (Cost is included) will take place in the centre of the old town - where the Hoai River flows smoothly. The lanterns in Hoi An are made of colourful paper, cut and folded very cleverly (15 minutes by boat) Starting to release the lanterns is around 6pm, when Hoi An Ancient Town lights up, the guide will take you to the Hoai River area, sit on the boat to buy lanterns, make wishes and release the lanterns.

Day 07: Danang – Bana Hills – Danang

Breakfast at the hotel

08:30 The driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel and transfer to Ba Na Hills cable car station. Board one of the world's longest cable cars, enjoying stunning views of the forest and waterfalls along the way.

09:00 Arrive at Station 2. Take the mountain train (included in the ticket) to explore Ba Na Hills.

09:30 Visit the Golden Bridge, the world-famous pedestrian bridge held by giant stone hands, offering panoramic views of Da Nang city. Take photos and enjoy free time at this iconic landmark.

Continue to visit Le Jardin D'Amour Flower Garden (included), Linh Ung Pagoda, and the French Wine Cellar (Debay Wine Cellar).

Note: Entry to the wine cellar is optional and subject to a small surcharge if you wish to taste wine.

10:45 Take the second cable car ride to the top of Ba Na Mountain, at an altitude of 1,487 meters above sea level.

11:00 Arrive at Fantasy Park – the largest indoor amusement park in Southeast Asia (included in the ticket).

Enjoy free access to over 100 games and activities such as:

4D, 5D cinemas, Bumper cars, Rock climbing wall, Drop tower, Jurassic Park and Ghost House, Indoor slide, video games, and more

Note: Certain attractions such as the Wax Museum, Carnival Skill Games, and VR experiences are not included and require a surcharge.

12:00 Have lunch at a buffet restaurant inside Ba Na Hills (included).

13:00 Free time to explore the French Village, take photos, or enjoy the cool mountain climate.

14:30 – 15:30 Take the cable car down and meet your driver.

Return to the hotel and rest.

Start to Cu Chi Tunnel, before entering the tunnels visitors can watch a short introductory video showing how the tunnels were constructed. You will spend the next hour exploring the tunnels.

Afterwards, enjoy tea, cassava (guerrilla's food during the war). Cu Chi Tunnels is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese & foreign tourists - the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War.

In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centres & kitchens.

Day 09: Saigon – Mekong delta - Saigon

Breakfast at hotel.

08:30 Driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel

Start your journey with a comfortable pick-up from your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City and head to the peaceful Mekong Delta countryside.

Visit a local honey farm, where you can enjoy a cup of fresh honey tea and learn about traditional beekeeping.

Continue with an electric car ride through quiet village roads lined with fruit gardens and coconut trees.

Relax and enjoy Southern Vietnamese folk music (Đờn Ca Tài Tử) while tasting a selection of fresh tropical fruits prepared by locals.

Experience a rowing boat trip along narrow canals shaded by water coconut palms — a perfect way to feel the tranquil rhythm of life in the Mekong.

Then, visit a coconut candy workshop, where you can watch how the famous sweet candies are made and sample some freshly cooked treats.

Finally, return to Ho Chi Minh City with beautiful memories of the countryside and friendly local people.
