***Day 02: Kok Tobe Hill, Almaty City Tour, Panfilov Park & Zenkov Cathedral***

Visit to Kok Tobe Hill -KokTobe is the highest point in the city of Almaty standing on a 1100 m hill at the south-east edge of the city. It is worth a visit to KokTobe because of its panoramic view of the city from all directions. To reach the KokTobe hill, one should take a cable car ride which starts near Hotel Novotel and goes over some of the oldest parts of Almaty and the magnificent fruit growing gardens. Once you reach the KokTobe hill, you would see the famous 372 m high TV Tower which is visible from far and offers great views of the mountains and the city plus many attractions at the top including many restaurants serving cuisines from across the globe.

Almaty city tour

Explore the city of Almaty by quickly getting acquainted with discovering major areas of interest – During this introductory tour, you will visit the First President Park, Republic square, State Opera and Ballet Theatre, museums at the Academy of Sciences, Abay Square, Kazakhstan Hotel, Palace of the Republic.

Panfilov Park & Zenkov Cathedral

The Park is named and dedicated to the Panfilov Heroes who were 28 soldiers of an Almaty Infantry. Their memories are etched at the fearsome war memorial east of the Zenkov Cathedral which depict soldiers from all 15 soviet republics on the map of USSR. The Park is lush green area and it's a good place to sit, rest, relax and see the bustling sights of the city.

'Zenkov Cathedral', is one of the most beautiful, magnificent, and architectural monuments of the city of Almaty with the height of 56 meters and is in the green Panfilov Park of Almaty. A. Zenkov had supervised the construction of this cathedral in the early 19th century and legend goes that it was built without a single nail. But unfortunately, it's not true. Although the design is remarkably unique but it's because of the advanced technological expertise of that time.

***Day 03: Visit the Shymbulak Ski resort, Green Bazaar + Rakhat Chocolate Shop, Shopping time***

Visit the Shymbulak Ski resort – Level 3 via Gondola in just 1 hour, you can get from Almaty city center to its highest point (3200 meters) and drink coffee in the highest bar in the CIS using 3 tier world-class Gondola. On Shymbulak, you can have a great time even if you can't ski or snowboard. An all-day entertainment for the whole family is provided by cafes and restaurants with excellent cuisine, an observation deck with powerful binoculars that rotate 360 degrees and a playground. For those who want to enjoy the mountain silence and admire the snowy slopes, the resort offers high-class hotels and various kinds of adventure activities such as ZipLining, Paragliding, Horse riding etc.

**Green Bazaar + Rakhat Chocolate Shop**

If you are among these, who don't like to go to a mall and prefer the outdoor market among fresh air and belong to the old-school shopping type, then without wasting any time, head straight towards the Zelyony Bazaar located close to the Panfilov Park in Almaty. Also, known as the Green Market, this market is your typical local market where you can purchase everything starting from meat to spices to fruits to even clothes and furniture. The key to shopping here is that you should have a flair for bargaining, and you can get everything at a very reasonable rate. You will be delighted to see the colourful atmosphere and the variety of goods available.

Right next door is the famous Rakhat Chocolate shop. Rakhat which means pleasure in Kazakh is the oldest manufacturer of chocolates dating back to almost 70 years. Around 3500 workers work in basically 2 factories, one located in Almaty and one in Shymkent city. They also make chocolates for people suffering from diabetes and their low-calorie products like candies, cookies and waffles are a range among the people and tourists.

***Day 05: Full Day Tbilisi City Tour***

After breakfast our driver guide will pick you up from the hotel;

Today you will have a city tour in the capital of Georgia - Tbilisi which is considered as one of the most ancient cities in the Caucasus.

Tbilisi for a city tour where you can take a cable car/ropeway to Narikala Fortress to enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the city. Walk down to the district of Sulphur bath houses passing by the only mosque in Tbilisi. You will stroll through the Shardeni area - full of narrow streets with cozy cafés, wine tasting bars, souvenir shops, and breathe in the living past. You are able to visit Anchiskhati Basilica and the clock tower of the famous Rezo Gabriadze Theatre.

***Day 06: Ananuri-Gudauri-Kazbegi Tour***

Our driver will pick you up at your hotel. The route will take over the Georgian Military Highway up North towards the border with Russia;

Your first stop will be at Ananuri fortress which is a sixteenth century castle complex on the Aragvi River. The fortress stands beside the famous Georgian Military Highway, overlooking a large Jinali lake. Its high, turreted stone walls protect two churches, a watch tower and a reservoir. The main church facade is beautifully carved with animal, floral and Celtic style patterns;

Next Stop is Gudauri – a young and rapidly developing winter sports resort located at Kazbegi region of Georgia, 120 km from Tbilisi, at the height of 2,196 m (about 7,200 feet) near the Cross Pass. Skiing season lasts from December to April. In summer Gudauri is calm. Green environment, cool weather and clean air make a positive impact on the general health condition of people.

After that drive to Gergeti Trinity Church - At an altitude of 7119 feet (2,170 meters), the twelfth or thirteenth century monument was erected on the southern slopes of Mkinvarcveri. Gergeti Trinity Church is an important temple, remarkable for its beautiful scenery. The Gergeti Trinity Church is set poignantly on a hill directly below the towering white massif of Mount Kazbek, which sits at 5,033 meters. Built six hundred years ago, its stones have weathered repeated blizzards, rain and invasion to stand as a proud symbol of Georgian resilience in the face of adversity. It is the photographer's perfect shot.

***Day 07: Tbilisi - Sadakhlo border - Yerevan***

Explore Lake Sevan, one of the largest freshwater high-altitude lakes in the world. The lake is surrounded by beautiful mountains and is a major tourist destination. Visit Sevanavank Monastery on the Sevan Peninsula for panoramic views of the lake, take a walk along the shores, and learn about the significance of Lake Sevan in Armenian culture and history.

Explore the charming town of Dilijan, known as the "Switzerland of Armenia" for its lush forests and picturesque landscapes.

Stroll through the town's old district, visit the local art galleries or handicraft shops, and enjoy the natural beauty of the area. If you're interested in hiking, there are nearby trails with scenic views.

Continue the journey to Lake Parz, located about 10 minutes (8 km) outside of Dilijan. Drive to Haghartsin Monastery, located 15 minutes (12 km) from Lake Parz.

Explore this impressive medieval monastery, nestled in a forested valley. The complex includes several churches and structures; all set against stunning natural surroundings.

***Day 08: Yerevan city tour***

Half day Yerevan City tour - Republic Square: The heart of Yerevan, known for its stunning architecture and fountains, offering a glimpse into the city's vibrant history.

Cascades Complex: A giant stairway offering panoramic views of Yerevan and Mount Ararat, with the Gafesjian Museum of Art at its base.

Armenian Genocide Memorial and Museum: A solemn site commemorating the victims of the Armenian Genocide, offering a moving and educational experience. Vernissage Market: An open-air market where you can buy traditional Armenian crafts, souvenirs, and artwork to remember your visit.

### ***Day 09: Garni Temple, Geghard Monastery***

Explore the Garni Temple, Armenia's only pagan temple, which dates back to the 1st century AD. Enjoy the views of the surrounding mountains and the Azat River Gorge. Learn about the history of the temple, its architectural significance, and its connection to pre-Christian Armenia.

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Geghard Monastery, renowned for its rock-cut architecture and its dramatic location in the cliffs of the Azat River Gorge.

Visit the church, enjoy the peaceful atmosphere, and learn about its history, especially its role as a spiritual centre in medieval Armenia.
