Day 01:Hanoi arrival – Hanoi Half day City tour

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you will be warmly greeted by our guide and driver.

Have lunch at Indian restaurant in Hanoi . Check in to the hotel.

14:30 Start Hanoi Half day City Tour:

- Visiting the Temple of Literature, which is well known as the first university of Vietnam.
- Next to Tran Quoc Pagoda - located on an east side isle of the West Lake (Tay Ho district), It is considered as the most ancient pagoda in Thang Long - Ha Noi with its historical progression in 1500 years. It has a harmonious combination between the majesty, hoariness architecture and peaceful landscape of the West Lake. From the period in the Ly and Tran dynasties, it had become the Buddhist center of Thang Long.

We will continue to visit the peaceful lake of Hoan Kiem. After that, we will visit St. Joseph's Cathedral. It is a late 19th-century Gothic Revival church that serves as the cathedral of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Hanoi to nearly 4 million Catholics in the country.

Day 02 :Hanoi – Halong bay – Luon cave – Titop island

07:30–08:00 Pick-up from a hotel in Hanoi Old Quarter and transfer to Halong Bay.

11:30–12:00 Arrival at Tuan Chau International Cruise Port and check-in procedures.

12:00 Board Cruise and begin the journey through Halong Bay.

Lunch will be served while cruising towards Luon Cave.

14:00 Explore Luon Cave by kayak or bamboo boat.

16:00 Visit Titop Island for swimming or hiking to the viewpoint for panoramic views of Halong Bay.

17:30 Sunset Party & Cooking Class on board.

19:30 Dinner and overnight on the cruise.

Day 03: Halong Bay – Hanoi

06:15 - start your day with a refreshing Tai Chi session on the sundeck at dawn, taking in the serene beauty of Halong Bay.

07:30 Visit Sung Sot Cave, one of the largest and most impressive caves in Halong Bay.

09:30 Check-out procedures.

10:00 Early lunch on board.

11:00 Disembark at Tuan Chau Marina and transfer back to Hanoi.

14:30 Check in hotel in Hanoi.

Note: The travel time from Halong Bay to Hanoi is approximately 3.5 hours. The guests are expected to arrive in Hanoi between 14:40 and 15:30, depending on traffic conditions.

Around 15:00 Our driver and tour guide will pick you up from your hotel to begin your half-day exploration of Hanoi. Start at Ba Dinh Square, the historic heart of the capital, where many important national events have taken place. Continue to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (*outside only*), an iconic and solemn landmark dedicated to the founding father of Vietnam.

Just nearby, visit the unique One Pillar Pagoda, an architectural symbol of Hanoi, designed to resemble a lotus flower rising from the water.

Then, head to Train Street and then go to watch Water Puppet Show.

19:00 – 19:30: Have dinner at the Indian Restaurant.

13:30 Visit Bay Mau Coconut Forest on basket boats, a typical vehicle of the fishing village ,of Van Lang village. You can see the local people casting their nets on the river to catch fish and can experience their own casting skills.

Then, watch the unique basket-shaking performance of the basket-shaking artisan of Van Lang village

You will discover the city of Hoi An on foot. This historic city, which was a prosperous port city from the 16th to the 18th century, is now a beautiful city not to be missed. We will transfer to go to Hoi An Old Town. You will have an

opportunity to visit Hoi An Market, Historical House, Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, Japanese Covered Bridge

and Art Craft Manufacturing with artwork galleries in the town. Admire Hoi An at sunset, this is a very romantic time

Release lanterns in Hoi An (Cost is included) will take place in the center of the old town - where the Hoai River

flows smoothly. The lanterns in Hoi An are made of colourful paper, cut and folded very cleverly (15 minutes by boat) Starting to release the lanterns is around 6pm, when Hoi An Ancient Town lights up, the guide will take you to the Hoai River area, sit on the boat to buy lanterns, make wishes and release the lanterns. Have dinner at Indian restaurant in Hoi an and return to the hotel in Danang

Overnight in Danang.

Day 05: Danang – Ba Na Hills

Breakfast at the hotel

08:30 The driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel and transfer to Ba Na Hills cable car station. Board one of the world's longest cable cars, enjoying stunning views of the forest and waterfalls along the way.

09:00 Arrive at Station 2. Take the mountain train (included in the ticket) to explore Ba Na Hills.

09:30 Visit the Golden Bridge, the world-famous pedestrian bridge held by giant stone hands, offering panoramic views of Da Nang city. Take photos and enjoy free time at this iconic landmark. Continue to visit Le Jardin D'Amour Flower Garden (included), Linh Ung Pagoda, and the French Wine Cellar (Debay Wine Cellar).

Note: Entry to the wine cellar is optional and subject to a small surcharge if you wish to taste wine.

10:45 Take the second cable car ride to the top of Ba Na Mountain, at an altitude of 1,487 meters above sea level.

11:00 Arrive at Fantasy Park – the largest indoor amusement park in Southeast Asia (included in the ticket). Enjoy free access to over 100 games and activities such as: 4D, 5D cinemas, Bumper cars , Rock climbing wall, Drop tower ,Jurassic Park and Ghost House , Indoor slide, video games, and more

Note: Certain attractions such as the Wax Museum, Carnival Skill Games, and VR experiences are not included and require a surcharge.

12:00 Have lunch at a buffet restaurant inside Ba Na Hills (included).

13:00 Free time to explore the French Village, take photos, or enjoy the cool mountain climate.

14:30 – 15:30 Take the cable car down and meet your driver. Return to the hotel and rest.

Note: The ticket includes round-trip cable car rides as well as visits to impressive landmarks such as the Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, and Moon Castle (apart from the wax museum, Debay wine cellar, and several games).

Day 06: Danang – Saigon by flight – Cu Chi tunnels

Breakfast at the hotel

Check out and transfer to airport for the flight to Saigon

Upon arrive in Saigon, you will be greeted by our guide and driver

Have lunch at Indian restaurant in Saigon

Start to Cu Chi Tunnel, before entering the tunnels visitors can watch a short introductory video showing how the tunnels were constructed. You will spend the next hour exploring the tunnels.

Afterwards, enjoy tea, cassava (guerrilla's food during the war). Cu Chi Tunnels is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese & foreign tourists - the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centres & kitchens. Comes back to Saigon and check in the hotel

19:00 Have dinner at Indian restaurant in Saigon

Day 07: Saigon – Mekong Delta

Breakfast at hotel

08:30 Driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel

Start your journey with a comfortable pick-up from your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City and head to the peaceful Mekong Delta countryside. Visit a local honey farm, where you can enjoy a cup of fresh honey tea and learn about traditional beekeeping. Relax and enjoy Southern Vietnamese folk music (Đờn Ca Tài Tử) while tasting a selection of fresh tropical fruits prepared by locals. Experience a rowing boat trip along narrow canals shaded by water coconut palms —a perfect way to feel the tranquil rhythm of life in the Mekong.

Then, visit a coconut candy workshop, where you can watch how the famous sweet candies are made and sample some freshly cooked treats. Finally, return to Ho Chi Minh City with beautiful memories of the countryside and friendly local people.

Day 08: Saigon half day city tour – Departure

Breakfast at hotel and check out.

In the morning, start with a visit to the Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace. Built on the site of the former Norodom Palace, it stands as a prominent landmark of Ho Chi Minh City, designed by architect Ngo Viet Thu.

Next, visit some beautiful examples of French Colonial architecture, including the Notre Dame Cathedral (viewed from the outside due to ongoing construction) and the historic Central Post Office.

Continue to the War Remnants Museum, which offers a comprehensive display of both the Indochina wars, providing deep insights into the wartime history and its impact.

Take lunch box and transfer to the airport with driver (no guide) for your departure flight.
