Day 01:Hanoi arrival – Hanoi Half day City tour

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you will be warmly greeted by our guide and driver.

Have lunch at Indian restaurant in Hanoi . Check in to the hotel.

14:30 Start Hanoi Half day City Tour:

- Visiting the Temple of Literature, which is well known as the first university of Vietnam.
- Next to Tran Quoc Pagoda - located on an east side isle of the West Lake (Tay Ho district), It is considered as the most ancient pagoda in Thang Long - Ha Noi with its historical progression in 1500 years. It has a harmonious combination between the majesty, hoariness architecture and peaceful landscape of the West Lake. From the period in the Ly and Tran dynasties, it had become the Buddhist center of Thang Long. We will continue to visit the peaceful lake of Hoan Kiem. After that, we will visit St. Joseph's Cathedral. It is a late 19th-century Gothic Revival church that serves as the cathedral of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Hanoi to nearly 4 million Catholics in the country. Day 02 :Hanoi – Halong Bay

After breakfast at the hotel and check-out, transfer to Ha Long Bay by the Private transfers.

Upon arrival, board the cruise and begin your journey through the stunning Ha Long Bay while enjoying a lunch of local cuisine on board. Ha Long Bay, meaning "Descending Dragon Bay" in Vietnamese, is steeped in legend as the place where a sacred dragon descended from the sky. The bay, recognized as one of the world's wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, boasts around 2,000 karst islands and islets spread over 1,553 km², with a geological history dating back 500 million years.

After lunch, participate in a guided tour of a grotto, where you'll marvel at the fascinating formations of stalactites and stalagmites. Continue with a visit to a nearby island, where you can relax on the beach or take a short hike to a viewpoint for a panoramic view of the bay.

As the day winds down, return to the cruise to unwind and take in the breathtaking bay view at sunset. Then, join a cooking class where you can learn to make traditional Vietnamese dishes and later enjoy a dinner featuring local specialties on board.

In the evening, join in on optional activities such as squid fishing. Overnight on the cruise.

Note: The cruise itinerary may vary based on your chosen cruise. A stationed English-speaking guide will be available on board.

Day 03: Halong Bay – Hanoi

In the morning, start your day with a refreshing Tai Chi session on the sundeck at dawn, taking in the serene beauty of Ha Long Bay. Enjoy tea and coffee on board as you continue exploring the bay's stunning 2,000 islets and some of its major highlights.

Later, you have the option to go kayaking or take a bamboo boat ride to explore hidden lagoons and get up close to the towering limestone cliffs.

Around 9:00, check out of your cabin and savor a brunch (local food) while cruising back toward the shore.

As you approach the mainland, enjoy some final moments on the deck, taking in the last views of the magnificent bay. Disembark at around 11:00 AM and transfer back to Hanoi by Private car.

*Visit Bay Mau Coconut Forest on basket boats, a typical vehicle of the fishing village ,of Van Lang village. You can see the local people casting their nets on the river to catch fish and can experience their own casting skills. Then, watch the unique basket-shaking performance of the basket-shaking artisan of Van Lang village

You will discover the city of Hoi An on foot. This historic city, which was a prosperous port city from the 16th to the 18th century, is now a beautiful city not to be missed. We will transfer to go to Hoi An Old Town. You will have an opportunity to visit Hoi An Market, Historical House, Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, Japanese Covered Bridge and Art Craft Manufacturing with artwork galleries in the town. Admire Hoi An at sunset, this is a very romantic time

Release lanterns in Hoi An (Cost is included) will take place in the center of the old town - where the Hoai River flows smoothly. The lanterns in Hoi An are made of colourful paper, cut and folded very cleverly (15 minutes by boat)

Starting to release the lanterns is around 6pm, when Hoi An Ancient Town lights up, the guide will take you to the Hoai River area, sit on the boat to buy lanterns, make wishes and release the lanterns. Have dinner at Indian

Day 05: Danang – Ba Na Hills

Breakfast at the hotel

08:30 The driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel and transfer to Ba Na Hills cable car station. Board one of the world's longest cable cars, enjoying stunning views of the forest and waterfalls along the way.

09:00 Arrive at Station 2. Take the mountain train (included in the ticket) to explore Ba Na Hills.

09:30 Visit the Golden Bridge, the world-famous pedestrian bridge held by giant stone hands, offering panoramic views of Da Nang city. Take photos and enjoy free time at this iconic landmark. Continue to visit Le Jardin D'Amour Flower Garden (included), Linh Ung Pagoda, and the French Wine Cellar (Debay Wine Cellar).

Note: Entry to the wine cellar is optional and subject to a small surcharge if you wish to taste wine.

10:45 Take the second cable car ride to the top of Ba Na Mountain, at an altitude of 1,487 meters above sea level.

11:00 Arrive at Fantasy Park – the largest indoor amusement park in Southeast Asia (included in the ticket). Enjoy free access to over 100 games and activities such as: 4D, 5D cinemas, Bumper cars, Rock climbing wall, Drop tower, Jurassic Park and Ghost House, Indoor slide, video games, and more

Note: Certain attractions such as the Wax Museum, Carnival Skill Games, and VR experiences are not included and require a surcharge.

12:00 Have lunch at a buffet restaurant inside Ba Na Hills (included).

13:00 Free time to explore the French Village, take photos, or enjoy the cool mountain climate.

14:30 – 15:30 Take the cable car down and meet your driver. Return to the hotel and rest.

Note: The ticket includes round-trip cable car rides as well as visits to impressive landmarks such as the Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, and Moon Castle (apart from the wax museum, Debay wine cellar, and several games).

Day 06: Danang – Saigon by flight – Cu Chi tunnels

Breakfast at the hotel

Check out and transfer to airport for the flight to Saigon

Have lunch at Indian restaurant in Saigon

Start to Cu Chi Tunnel, before entering the tunnels visitors can watch a short introductory video showing how the tunnels were constructed. You will spend the next hour exploring the tunnels.

Afterwards, enjoy tea, cassava (guerrilla's food during the war). Cu Chi Tunnels is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese & foreign tourists - the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centres & kitchens. Comes back to Saigon and check in the hotel

19:00 Have dinner at Indian restaurant in Saigon

Day 07: Saigon – Mekong Delta

Breakfast at hotel

08:30 Driver and guide will pick you up at the hotel

Start your journey with a comfortable pick-up from your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City and head to the peaceful Mekong Delta countryside. Visit a local honey farm, where you can enjoy a cup of fresh honey tea and learn about traditional beekeeping. Continue with an electric car ride through quiet village roads lined with fruit gardens and coconut trees.

Relax and enjoy Southern Vietnamese folk music (Đờn Ca Tài Tử) while tasting a selection of fresh tropical fruits prepared by locals. Experience a rowing boat trip along narrow canals shaded by water coconut palms —a perfect way to feel the tranquil rhythm of life in the Mekong.

Then, visit a coconut candy workshop, where you can watch how the famous sweet candies are made and sample some freshly cooked treats. Finally, return to Ho Chi Minh City with beautiful memories of the countryside and friendly local people.
